The DF business year starts and ends in early September, at our Annual General Meeting held at the residential business event, Althing. It is named after the world's oldest parliamentary system, that of Iceland. Here is where the DF committee, regional council and other key DF roles are elected, for which any member of the Woodcraft folk of DF age may stand. It is run by committee themselves, and expects around 60 people for one weekend, although the weather is usually nice so part camping can be nice so long as there is a large meeting room. DF committee and regional council are obliged to attend so do not pay.

For each motion, the minutes explain who proposed it, what it would change, why? how Althing felt about it, any amendments we made, actions to be taken and if the motion fell or was carried. For this zine, I tried to summarise general feeling from these, but keep in mind that there were still a range of opinions and votes.

Motion 24-01 (No Brunch)

RATIONALE If you were at summer camp, this will be selfexplanatory This motion was carried, brunch is now banned.

Motion 24-02 (Change to the Food Policy).
This was about meat on camp. We wanted to leave these issues for coord teams to look at for individual events, so this motion fell.

Motion 24-03 (Preventing Laymember Overexertion)
This motion was amended and then passed, so that going forward, one person may not hold more than one role on DF committee.

Motion 24-04 (Altering the two-stage Election Process)
This motion was carried, so that for specific roles when only
one candidate runs, and no one votes against them, we don't
need a second voting round. (Basically, we streamlined an over
complicated process to reduce admin.)

Motion 24-05 (Change to the Shift Policy)
Honestly this one made my head hurt a bit, it was about ratios
of DFs on shift, and a wider discussion about the ways to
improve shifts and the orange high vis role. It was amended

twice then carried.

Motion 24-06 (Manchester Liaison)

Some haters wanted the Manchester liaison role gone.

Obviously, this motion fell.

Motion 24-07 (Two Events Reps)

We want less stress for our incredible event reps, but this opened up a wider discussion about support systems, previous shared roles, and pressure from implied expectations. This motion fell, as we wanted Old/New to look at rewriting some descriptions instead.

Motion 24-08 (Committee and Non-Committee)
This motion was amended and passed so that the sustainability role becomes supervisory.

Motion 24-09 (DF Moots)

This motion was carried and amended our constitution to explain how working groups can be set up to tackle specific topics, and name them Moots.

Motion 24-10 (2027 Moot)

This was about setting up a 2027 Moot to plan for the 50th anniversary of DF! The motion was carried so thanks Delilah for getting us talking about it, now let's get planning!

Motion 24-11 (International Moot)

This motion was carried to establish a Moot to work on international participation at DF events, and DF participation internationally.

Motion 24-12 (No clan for coord team)

We considered all the work that coord teams put in, before and during camp, and how we want to encourage people to join coord teams. This motion carried.

Motion 24-13 ("Manchester Leiasgon")

This Althing changes the title of the Manchester Liaison role to "Manchester Leiasgon" [including quotation marks]. Each time it is spoken aloud, it must be with air quotes.

Some of us felt Spring Awakening sometimes falls short, since it sits by an exam period that makes it a smaller event, no matter what we do. We had a bit of a rethink about what we want it to be and reducing stress on DFs. We suggested a more chill, wellbeing focused event, with support from MEST-UP and potentially a revision space. As always, its up to future events teams what comes of this, so get involved, and let us know what you think.


Integration of different groups of DFs

No one knew how to coordinate transport to events quite


like him. We will treasurer the memories of all those crazy
